

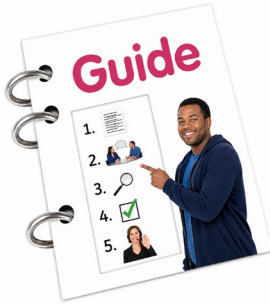

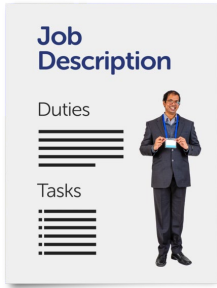

This training was made after a man called Oliver McGowan died in a hospital.



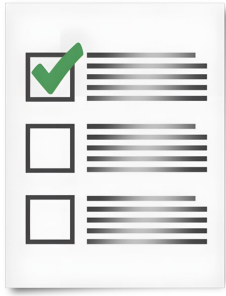
Oliver was an autistic person with a learning disability.



The training helps people understand how to support people with learning disabilities and autism better.



Everyone who works in health and social care should do this training.



What you will do



In this job, you will:

- Work with other people to give the training to our staff



- Help people learn more about learning disabilities and autism



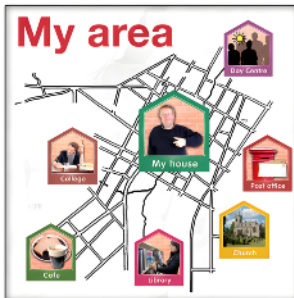
- Help make training videos and guides



- Share your experiences and stories



Where and how you will work



The job will be based near where you live.



At the start, the training you give will be online.



This means using a computer, tablet, or phone to give the training.



Sometimes, the training may happen in person.



You may need to travel across the country sometimes.



Who we are looking for



To apply for this job, you must:

- Be autistic or have a learning disability



- Be happy telling your story to other people



- Be able to listen and speak to others well



- Be able to learn and remember training information



- Be comfortable talking to big groups of people



How we will support you



We will:

- Teach you how to give the training



- Support you to improve your skills and confidence



- Make changes that help you work in the best way



How to apply



To apply for this job, you need to send us a short video.



Your video should tell us:

- Your name



- Why you want to do this job



- Your experience of having a learning disability or autism



- How you think staff could support people better



Your video only needs to be 2 to 3 minutes long



You can record it on a phone, tablet or laptop.

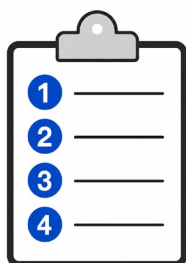

What happens next



After you send us your video, there are 4 steps.



Step 1: We will contact you before Friday 17th July 2026.



You can ask us questions and learn more about the job.



Step 2: If we think you are right for the job, we will ask you to meet us in person.



You will learn more about the job and practice talking to a group of people.



Step 3: We will teach you how to give the training.



Step 4: If everything goes well, you will start giving the training.
